To support this goal, President Samia noted that the government has increased the budget for agriculture by fourfold compared to the previous year and is launching initiatives to improve irrigation systems, create sustainable food systems, and support young people in the agricultural sector. More so, the government has come up with a block farming method that also aims at enhancing the production of food crops, among other measures which in turn will play a great role in assuring food security.
